

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Title 4 of the Lincoln Municipal Code relating to Board
2 and Commission by repealing Chapter 4.10 entitled "Community Development Task Force" in its
3 entirety by repealing Sections 4.10.010, 4.10.020, 4.10.030, and 4.10.040.

4 Section 1. That Section 4.10.010 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be and the same is
5 hereby repealed.

6 ~~4.10.010~~ **Community Development Task Force; Membership; Terms:**

7 ~~There is hereby established a twenty-five member advisory body to be known as the~~
8 ~~Community Development Task Force which shall be composed of one representative from the City~~
9 ~~Council to be chosen by the City Council and twenty-four representatives to be nominated by the~~
10 ~~Mayor and confirmed by a majority vote of the City Council. Mayoral nominees shall be~~
11 ~~representatives of low- and moderate-income neighborhoods with emphasis on diverse racial and~~
12 ~~ethnic backgrounds. A minimum of ten low- and moderate-income neighborhood representatives~~
13 ~~and a minimum of five at-large representatives of low- and moderate-income interests shall be~~
14 ~~included. A minimum of two members shall be appointed who represent local lending institutions~~
15 ~~who have made a commitment to low- and moderate-income neighborhoods of the city.~~

16 ~~Members serving on the currently existing Task Force shall serve on the recreated Task~~
17 ~~Force until August 1, 1997 at which time twenty-five members shall be appointed as provided~~
18 ~~above. The initial term of members appointed to the Task Force shall be staggered so that eight~~
19 ~~members are appointed for a one-year term, eight members are appointed for a two-year term, and~~
20 ~~nine members are appointed for a three-year term. Thereafter, all members of the Task Force shall~~
21 ~~be appointed for three-year terms. No member shall serve more than two full consecutive terms.~~

22 ~~Appointments to fill any vacancies on the Task Force shall be for the unexpired term of said~~
23 ~~member thereof whose term is being filled by such appointment. In the event the representative of~~
24 ~~the City Council ceases to be a member of the City Council, such representative's membership on~~
25 ~~the Task Force and the right to serve thereon shall forthwith terminate.~~

26 ~~The Mayor may remove any member of the Task Force who fails to attend more than two~~
27 ~~consecutive regular or special meetings without excuse, or a total of four regular or special meetings~~

1 ~~during the course of the program year, or when in the opinion of the Mayor the individual no longer~~
2 ~~is representative of community development concerns.~~

3 Section 2. That Section 4.10.020 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be and the same is
4 hereby repealed.

5 ~~**4.10.020**~~ ~~——~~ ~~**Secretarial and Staff Assistance.**~~

6 ~~——~~ ~~All necessary secretarial and other staff assistance for the Task Force shall be provided by~~
7 ~~the Urban Development Department.~~

8 Section 3. That Section 4.10.030 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be and the same is
9 hereby repealed.

10 ~~**4.10.030**~~ ~~——~~ ~~**Organization; Bylaws.**~~

11 ~~——~~ ~~The Task Force shall annually elect its chairperson and such other officers as it desires from~~
12 ~~among its members, and may formulate and adopt, amend, modify or repeal such bylaws and rules~~
13 ~~of procedure as it may deem necessary or expedient. The Task Force shall meet at least every two~~
14 ~~months; provided, however, special meetings of the Task Force may be called by the chairperson,~~
15 ~~or by any five members of the Task Force. Thirteen members shall constitute a quorum for the~~
16 ~~transaction of business, and thirteen affirmative votes shall be required for final action on any matter~~
17 ~~acted on by the Task Force.~~

18 Section 4. That Section 4.10.040 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be and the same is
19 hereby repealed.

20 ~~**4.10.040**~~ ~~——~~ ~~**Duties of the Task Force.**~~

21 ~~——~~ ~~The Community Development Task Force shall:~~

22 ~~——~~ ~~(a) Act in an advisory capacity to the Mayor and City Council regarding the performance~~
23 ~~of all City functions relating to the application, receipt, and expenditure of federal grant funds~~
24 ~~available to the City under the various federal housing and community development acts;~~

25 ~~——~~ ~~(b) Hold one or more public hearings annually to obtain the views of citizens on~~
26 ~~community development and housing needs; and~~

27 ~~——~~ ~~(c) Recommend to the Mayor and City Council a proposed statement of community~~
28 ~~development objectives and projected use of community development block grant funds.~~

29 Section 5. Pursuant to Article VII, Section 7 of the City Charter, this ordinance
30 shall be posted on the official bulletin board of the City in lieu of and in place of newspaper

1 publication with notice of passage and such posting to be given by publication one time in the
2 official newspaper by the City Clerk. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after
3 its passage and publication as herein and in the City Charter provided.
