

RESOLUTION NO. A-_____

1 WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 was signed in to law on October
2 30, 2000, placing new emphasis on state and local mitigation planning for natural hazards and
3 requiring communities to adopt a hazard mitigation action plan to be eligible for pre-disaster and
4 post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

5 WHEREAS, a Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, which includes the jurisdiction
6 of the City of Lincoln Nebraska, was prepared in accordance with FEMA requirements at 44 C.F.R.
7 201.6, by Lower Platte South Natural Resources District with assistance from JEO Consulting
8 Group, Inc. of Lincoln, Nebraska; and

9 WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln participated in the preparation of the plan and affirms that
10 the plan will be updated no less than every five years; and

11 WHEREAS, the purpose of the mitigation plan was to lessen the affects of disasters by
12 increasing the disaster resistance of the District and participating jurisdictions located within the
13 planning boundary by identifying the hazards that affect the District and prioritize mitigation
14 strategies to reduce potential loss of life and property damage from those hazards, and

15 WHEREAS, FEMA regulations require documentation that the plan has been formally
16 adopted by the governing body of Lincoln, Nebraska in the form of a resolution and further
17 requesting approval of the plan at the Federal Level;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of Lincoln, Nebraska, does herewith approve and
19 adopt the portions of the Lower Platte South NRD Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan

- 1 which pertain to the jurisdiction of the City of Lincoln, specifically sections 1 through 5 and the
- 2 Lincoln portion of section 6.
