REASON FOR LEGISLATION: Create and order constructed under Special Assessment District; water mains, 12-inch diameters, east of N. 56th Street, from Salt Creek to Arbor Road, and assess the costs thereof against the benefitted property.

D I S C U S S I O N

Petitioner requests the construction of 12-inch water mains east of N. 56th Street, from Salt Creek to Arbor Road. The area is currently served by private wells and there are continuing issues with the quality and supply of water from the wells. Many of the property owners in the area have been working toward annexation and obtaining city utility services for nearly 15-years. Water mains have recently been constructed (or are under contract for construction) which are capable of serving this area.
