

AMENDMENT No. 2
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE NEBRASKA GAME AND PARKS
COMMISSION AND THE CITY OF LINCOLN PARKS AND RECREATION
DEPARTMENT

(Regarding the Lincoln Archery Range at Boosalis Park)

The undersigned parties mutually agree to amend the Cooperative Agreement dated March 3, 2006 between the City of Lincoln Parks and Recreation Department (CLPR) and the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission (NGPC) as follows:

Item 9. Consultant

1. The City will hire a qualified consultant to work with the Commission toward developing a Master Plan and budget for the indoor shooting facility to include a small bore range and 30 meter 32 lane archery range, classrooms, offices, storage, restrooms, kitchen area, outdoor field range, youth 3D range, etc.
2. The City will provide for initial cost of the consultant.
3. The Commission will reimburse the City for consultant fees, excluding \$20,000 contributed by the City. Consultant price must be approved by the Commission.
4. The Commission will be allowed to choose the qualified consultant through an interview process, in consultation with the City.

All other terms and conditions of this agreement remain unchanged.
