REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To accept and approve an interlocal agreement between the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County, for roadway reconstruction on 98th Street from Yankee Hill Road to Pine Lake Road, and the establishment of maintenance responsibilities thereafter. The project lies partially outside the City limits of the City of Lincoln. This project is in the 2006 Highway User Allocation Bond.

D I S C U S S I O N

This project will reconstruct 98th Street from Yankee Hill Road to Pine Lake Road, as a curb and gutter, two lane section, off-set to the west with right turn lanes. Grading and cross-drainage structures will be completed first, followed by the paving and storm sewer laterals. A 24-inch water main will also be constructed along the west side of 98th Street from south of Andermatt Drive to Pine Lake Road.
