**REASON FOR LEGISLATION:** To assist with the process of the loading of snow onto trucks and hauling the snow to the “snow dump” from various large and small business districts across the City.

## **D I S C U S S I O N**

The Public Works, City Attorney, and the Police Departments have initiated these additions to the Lincoln Municipal Code to better define the streets within the various large & small business districts where if the city receives a significant amount of snow, the Public Works Department can request that the Mayor implement parking restrictions. In addition, these ordinances give more specific authority to the City to enforce parking restrictions within the defined “Snow Removal Districts” which will help to facilitate the snow blowing operations within these districts.
