

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 17366 and Ordinance No. 18214, which in
2 part authorized and directed the Department of Public Works and Utilities to proceed with the
3 preparation of detailed plans and specifications for the widening, reconstruction, and
4 improvement of Old Cheney Road from Nebraska Highway 2 to South 84th Street; to acquire
5 necessary rights-of-way and easements relating thereto; and to proceed with construction thereof.

6 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 17366, as amended by Ordinance No. 18214, authorized
7 construction of a roadway with four through lanes with left turn lanes, right turn lanes, and raised
8 medians from the intersection of South 70th Street to approximately 1450 feet east of the
9 intersection of South 84th Street; and

10 WHEREAS, input has been received from residents of the area of the proposed widening
11 of Old Cheney Road questioning the necessity for raised medians and right turn lanes for streets
12 in residential areas.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln,
14 Nebraska:

15 Section 1. That Section 1d of Ordinance No. 18214, which amended Ordinance No.
16 17366, be amended to as follows:

17 d. Construction of a roadway with four through lanes with left turn lanes and
18 raised medians in Old Cheney Road from the east leg of the Highway 2 intersection to
19 approximately 900 feet east of the centerline of Highway 2, then transitioning to four through
20 lanes with a TWLTL to approximately 250 feet east of the above described point, then

1 continuing with the TWLTL to a point approximately 1207 feet west of the intersection of South
2 70th Street, then transitioning to a cross-section with four through lanes and left turn lanes at a
3 point 547 feet west of the intersection of South 70th Street, then continuing with four through
4 lanes with left turn lanes, ~~right turn lanes, and raised medians~~ to approximately 1450 feet east of
5 the intersection of South 84th Street.

6 Section 2. Pursuant to Article VII, Section 7 of the City Charter, this ordinance shall be
7 posted on the official bulletin board of the City, located on the wall adjoining the City Clerk's
8 office at 555 S. 10th Street, in lieu of and in place of newspaper publication with notice of
9 passage and such posting to be given by publication one time in the official newspaper by the
10 City Clerk. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and
11 publication as herein and in the City Charter provided.
