The July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012, budget for the Railroad Transportation Safety District approved \$200,000 for the South Salt Creek Quiet Zone for the 2011-12 year as identified on the flow of funds statement.

These funds will be used for the construction of railroad-roadway crossing safety improvements necessary to create a Quiet Zone.
