TITLE: Use of public right-of-way permit for private conduit and fiber installation at Northwest 12th Street and West Bond Street.

APPLICANT: Molex Incorporated

REASON FOR LEGISLATION: Provide authority per 14.53 of the Lincoln Municipal Code for 2" pvc conduit and fiber installation.

D I S C U S S I O N

Molex Incorporated has submitted a request and drawing for a permit for installation of a 2 inch conduit with a 12 strand single mode fiber along West Bond Street and West Bond Circle west and east of Northwest 12th Street. This conduit and fiber will also cross Northwest 12th Street between West Bond Street and West Bond Circle.

Approval of this permit is per provisions of 14.53 of the Lincoln Municipal Code. The applicant has included the certificate for the \$5,000.00 continuing bond and the public liability insurance in the amount of \$500,000.00 with the certificate listing the City as an additional insured.

In addition, the Public Works & Utilities requests that the applicant become a member of the Nebraska One Call System to insure the fiber is located when utility and underground work occurs in this area.

The contractor hired to complete the installation must utilize the Nebraska One Call System prior to starting the work, and must coordinate all work in the public right-of-way with the Engineering Services Division.

Contractor or applicant must submit a copy of the as built drawings within 30 days of completion of the work.
