REASON FOR LEGISLATION: Amending Ordinance 19589 to allow for the design and construction of right-turn lanes at the intersection of 70th Street & Old Cheney Road.

D I S C U S S I O N

Ordinance 19589 removed right-turn lanes from the roadway improvement project on Old Cheney Road from 70th Street to 82nd Street. Engineering Services recommends amending this Ordinance to allow for northbound to eastbound right-turn, eastbound to southbound right-turn and westbound to northbound right-turn lanes at this intersection be included in the design and construction. This is an intersection of two arterial streets and providing right-turn lanes will provide better efficiency, safety and traffic flow. The intent of Ordinance 19589 was to remove right-turn lanes along Old Cheney Road between 70th Street and 82nd Street at the residential intersection to reduce property impacts.
