REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To provide authority for the Mayor to execute a Construction Engineering Agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads, so that the identified duties to be performed by City staff and the fees associated with those duties will be eligible for Federal Surface Transportation Program Funds on this street microsurfacing project in the City of Lincoln.

D I S C U S S I O N

The City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads wish to enter into an agreement to establish the responsibilities and fees for Construction Engineering (CE) services to be performed by City staff on the Lincoln Citywide Street Microsurfacing Project.

The total cost of Construction Engineering services for the project is estimated to be \$179,731 which includes services performed by the City, by the Department of Roads and an audit of the project upon completion. The Construction Engineering services will be partially funded (80%) by Federal Surface Transportation Program funds currently estimated to be \$143,785 with the City share (20%) estimated to be \$35,946. The project will be constructed in 2012.
