## DISCUSSION

Incremental fee increases are proposed for the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) stormwater permit compliance inspections. This revenue will allow the Department to provide required services, including: inspections, education, and investigations; assuring the City of Lincoln maintains compliance with its Federal MS4 Stormwater Permit; providing regulated industries compliance guidance; and protecting our stormwater system, lakes and streams from illicit discharges of pollutants. This revenue was part of the FY 13/14 Budget that was approved by the City Council.
