REASON FOR LEGISLATION:

Agreement between the county and the city to conduct roadside litter pickup along county roads by inmates.

DISCUSSION

Provides for an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County on behalf of Lancaster County Corrections Community Service Program to conduct roadside litter pickup along county roads by inmates and to provide supervision of the inmates providing the pickup. The City will pay the County based on \$50/mile of roadside litter pickup along county roads not to exceed \$7,000. The term of the Interlocal Agreement is from April 15, 2013 to May 31, 2014.
