REASON FOR LEGISLATION: Approve a resolution for the signing of a utility relocation agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR) setting out the various duties and funding responsibilities for this project.

D I S C U S S I O N

The City of Lincoln and NDOR wish to enter into an agreement which establish the responsibilities and funding requirements for the rehabilitation of City water line facilities at the intersection of U.S. Highway 6 and SW 40th St. in the City of Lincoln. These water line facilities will need to be rehabilitated due to the construction and widened right-of-way for the State of Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR) construction project at this intersection. NDOR has agreed to reimburse the City for 90% of its actual non-betterment expenses less any credit for salvaged or junked materials, as part of this rehabilitation.
