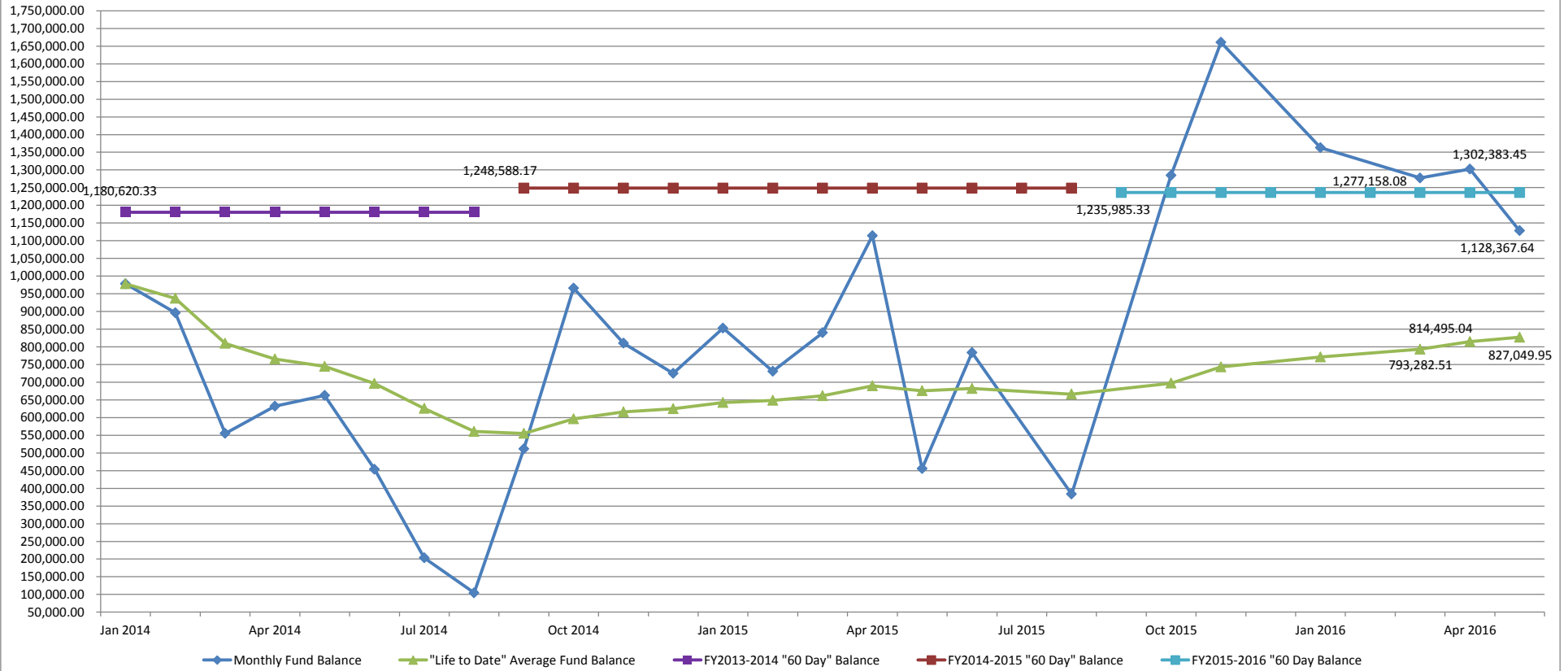

SYSTEMS DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

1. **City/County Payroll/HR –**

Kronos - Empower Software was purchased by Kronos software, which would make the Kronos payroll software the direct upgrade path for the County and City.

April – Based on the demo of the Kronos Workforce Ready software, it was determined that the Workforce Central software provides the functionality required by the County and City, specifically retroactive pay functionality. A demo of Workforce Ready is scheduled for June 9th. In addition, a demo of JDE payroll/HR options will be held on that day.

May – Reviewing the retroactive pay capabilities available in both Kronos Workforce Central and JDE World and EnterpriseOne as this will be an important feature in both systems.

2. **County EnterpriseOne 8.12 to 9.2 Upgrade –**

April – The consultants are currently engaged in functional tasks related to the upgrade.

Along with required technical support, IS is engaged in conversion of interface programs used to import data into EnterpriseOne from other County systems. The production upgrade date is scheduled for May 6th-8th.

May – The production system was upgraded on the weekend of May 6th-8th and the County began using the upgraded production application on May 9th.

3. **HP TRIM Records Management System upgrade –**

May – IS is working with Kapish and HP to resolve an issue with Records Manager/Outlook 2007 integration.

4. **Development Projects –**

Property Valuation Protest: Requested enhancements for the 2016 Property Protest period.

Parks & Rec Time Entry: A Time Entry system similar to the one utilized by Information Services will be developed for use by Parks and Rec.

April – Coding completed and application testing is underway.

May – Testing completed and application in production.

Mainframe web server plug-in: The state will be making mainframe software upgrades that will require a change in the technology used to deliver mainframe applications over the web. The changes are not significant, but will require modifications of several applications.
