

**Amendment to Agreement for Annual Supply of Pharmaceuticals for
Lincoln Fire & Rescue and US&R
Bid No. 11-186 - Third and Final Renewal with Price Increase**

This Amendment is hereby entered into by and between Bound Tree Medical, LLC, 5000 Tuttle Crossing Blvd., Dublin, OH 43016 (hereinafter "Contractor") and the City of Lincoln (hereinafter "City"), for the purpose of amending an Agreement dated October 26, 2011, under E. O. No. 84496, (the "Contract"), for the **Annual Supply of Pharmaceuticals for Lincoln Fire & Rescue and US&R, Bid No. 11-186**, which is made a part hereof by this reference.

WHEREAS, the original term of the Agreement is October 26, 2011 through October 25, 2012 with the option to renew for three (3) additional one (1) year terms upon written mutual consent of both parties; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was amended by the City to renew the agreement for an additional one year period from October 26, 2012 through October 25, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was amended by the City to renew agreement for an additional one (1) year term beginning October 26, 2013 through October 25, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to renew the agreement for an additional one (1) year term beginning October 26, 2014 through October 25, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement to reflect a price increase per **Attachment A** to the agreement for the term of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement to reflect addition an additional line item as listed on **Attachment B** for the term of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the estimated expenditures for City Departments for the term of this renewal shall not exceed \$50,000.00 without prior approval by the City of Lincoln.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants contained in the Contract, under City Executive Order No. 84496, and stated herein the parties agree as follows:

- 1) The parties wish to renew the agreement for an additional one (1) year term beginning October 26, 2014 through October 25, 2015
- 2) The parties wish to amend the Agreement to reflect a price increase per **Attachment A** for the term of the Agreement; and
- 3) The parties wish to amend the Agreement to reflect an additional line item as listed on **Attachment B** for the term of the Agreement; and
- 4) The estimated expenditures for City Departments for the term of this renewal shall not exceed \$50,000.00 without prior approval by the City of Lincoln.
- 5) All other terms of the Contract, not in conflict with this Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect.

The Parties do hereby agree to all the terms and conditions of this Amendment. This Amendment shall be binding upon the parties, their heirs, administrators, executors, legal and personal representatives, successors, and assigns.

- 3) All other terms of the Agreement, not in conflict with this Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect.



As you may know, Hospira manufactures many pharmaceuticals commonly used by EMS providers. Effective immediately, they have passed on a number of sizeable price increases. Below you will find a list of key items and the percentage that each has increased. While this list is specific to Bound Tree, we are told that these increases have occurred nationwide. Hospira attributed the increases to:

- Increased capital expenditures (due to needs to expand capacity)
- Need to qualify additional API suppliers (this helps provide them needed components to manufacture Hospira products)
- Requirements to meet higher FDA standards (Hospira is upgrading its facilities and is adding people, systems and equipment in Quality Assurance and Product Release Departments)

Since drug shortages began, various manufacturers have shared news of their voluntarily closing of plants for quality improvements. Increased manufacturer costs are also seen in the pending legislation relating to drug shortages. In order to fund a quicker review process of new drug applications by the FDA, they will require manufacturers to pay higher costs when filing new drug applications. The combined total paid to the FDA over the next 5 years is projected to be between \$5-6 billion.

While national news may provide validation of the increases, it doesn't help the great challenge that we face as a result – incorporating these changes into ever-tightening budgets. While many of the Hospira items affected are single source items, there are several items that have a lower cost option. To help you navigate these options, we have indicated several of them in the table below:

CONTRACT AGREEMENT**

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this _____ day of _____ 2011, by and between **Bound Tree Medical, LLC , 23537 Network Place, Chicago, IL 60673**, hereinafter called "Contractor", and the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, a municipal corporation, hereinafter called "City".

WHEREAS, the City has caused to be prepared, in accordance with law, Specifications, Plans, and other Contract Documents for the Work herein described, and has approved and adopted said documents and has caused to be published an advertisement for and in connection with said Work, to-wit:

For providing **Annual Supply of Pharmaceuticals for Lincoln Fire & Rescue and US&R, Bid No. 11-186** and,

WHEREAS, the Contractor, in response to such advertisement, has submitted to the City, in the manner and at the time specified, a sealed Proposal/Supplier Response in accordance with the terms of said advertisement; and,

WHEREAS, the City, in the manner prescribed by law has publicly opened, read aloud, examined, and canvassed the Proposals/Supplier Responses submitted in response to such advertisement, and as a result of such canvass has determined and declared the Contractor to be the lowest responsible bidder for the said Work for the sum or sums named in the Contractor's Proposal/Supplier Responses, a copy thereof being attached to and made a part of this Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sums to be paid to the Contractor and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Contractor and the City has agreed and hereby agree as follows:

1. The Contractor agrees to (a) furnish all tools, equipment, supplies, superintendence, transportation, and other accessories, services, and facilities; (b) furnish all materials, supplies, and equipment specified to be incorporated into and form a permanent part of the complete work; (c) provide and perform all necessary labor in a substantial and workmanlike manner and in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents; and (d) execute and complete all Work included in and covered by the City's award of this Contract to the Contractor, such award being based on the acceptance by the City of the Contractor's Proposal, or part thereof, as follows:

Agreement to full proposal

2. The City agrees to pay to the Contractor for the performance of the Work embraced in this Contract, the Contractor agrees to accept as full compensation therefore, the following sums and prices for all Work covered by and included in the Contract award and designated above, payment thereof to be made in the manner provided by the City:

City will pay for products/service, according to the Line Item pricing as listed in Contractors Proposal/Supplier Response, a copy thereof being attached to and made a part of this Contract. The City shall order on an as needed basis for the duration of the contract.

3. Equal Employment Opportunity. In connection with the carrying out of this project, the contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability, age or marital status. The Contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability, age or marital status. Such action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship.

4. E-Verify. In accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 4-108 through 4-114, the contractor agrees to register with and use a federal immigration verification system, to determine the work eligibility status of new employees performing services within the state of Nebraska. A federal immigration verification system means the electronic verification of the work authorization program of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, 8 U.S.C. 1324 a, otherwise known as the E-Verify Program, or an equivalent federal program designated by the United States Department of Homeland Security or other federal agency authorized to verify the work eligibility status of a newly hired employee pursuant to the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986. The Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment to be employed in the performance of this section pursuant to the requirements of state law and 8 U.S.C.A 1324b. The contractor shall require any subcontractor to comply with the provisions of this section.
5. Termination. This Contract may be terminated by the following:
 - 5.1) Termination for Convenience. Either party may terminate this Contract upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party for any reason without penalty.
 - 5.2) Termination for Cause. The City may terminate the Contract for cause if the Contractor:
 - 5.2.1) Refuses or fails to supply the proper labor, materials and equipment necessary to provide services and/or commodities.
 - 5.2.2) Disregards Federal, State or local laws, ordinances, regulations, resolutions or orders.
 - 5.2.3) Otherwise commits a substantial breach or default of any provision of the Contract Document. In the event of a substantial breach or default the City will provide the Contractor written notice of said breach or default and allow the Contractor ten (10) days from the date of the written notice to cure such breach or default. If said breach or default is not cured within ten (10) days from the date of notice, then the contract shall terminate.
6. Independent Contractor. It is the express intent of the parties that this contract shall not create an employer-employee relationship. Employees of the Contractor shall not be deemed to be employees of the City and employees of the City shall not be deemed to be employees of the Contractor. The Contractor and the City shall be responsible to their respective employees for all salary and benefits. Neither the Contractor's employees nor the City's employees shall be entitled to any salary, wages, or benefits from the other party, including but not limited to overtime, vacation, retirement benefits, workers' compensation, sick leave or injury leave. Contractor shall also be responsible for maintaining workers' compensation insurance, unemployment insurance for its employees, and for payment of all federal, state, local and any other payroll taxes with respect to its employees' compensation.
7. Contract Term. This Contract shall be effective upon execution by both parties. The term of the Contract shall be a one (1) year term with the option to renew for three (3) additional one (1) year terms.
8. The Contract Documents comprise the Contract, and consist of the following:
 1. Instructions to Bidders
 2. Federal Forms
 3. Accepted Proposal/Response
 4. Contract Agreement
 5. Specifications
 6. Special Provisions

These Contract Agreements, together with the other Contract Documents herein above mentioned, form this Contract, and they are as fully a part of the Contract as if hereto attached or herein repeated.

The Contractor and the City hereby agree that all the terms and conditions of this Contract shall be binding upon themselves, and their heirs, administrators, executors, legal and personal representatives, successors, and assigns.



- 1.1 It is the intent of this specification to describe the minimum acceptable requirements for The Annual Supply of Pharmaceuticals for Lincoln Fire & Rescue to be furnished and delivered to Lincoln Fire Department (LFR), 1801 "Q" Street Lincoln NE 68508.
- 1.2 Vendor shall submit bid documents and all supporting material via E-Bid.
 - 1.2.1 All inquiries regarding these specifications shall be directed via e-mail or faxed request to Shelly Hinze (rhinze@lincoln.ne.gov)

 - 1.2.2 These inquiries and/or responses shall be distributed to prospective bidders electronically as an addenda.
- 1.3 The term of this contract will be a (1) year term with the option to renew for (3) three additional (1) one year terms.
- 1.4 Items will be ordered on an as needed basis.

2. SCOPE

- 2.1 Lincoln Fire & Rescue provides both emergency and non-emergency ambulance services for the City of Lincoln with approximately 15,000 medical events each year.
- 2.2 All of the fourteen (14) engine companies and eleven (11) ambulances are staffed by a paramedic to provide Advanced Life Support.
- 2.3 Bid prices should include shipping costs.
- 2.4 Lincoln Fire and Rescue spends approximately \$45,000.00/year on pharmaceuticals.

- 3.1 Generic or alternatives to bid items may be suggested/offered but must be approved by LFR.
 - 3.1.1 Generic or alternatives shall be listed in the supplier notes section of the line items with its pricing.

**SPECIAL PROVISIONS
FOR
TERM CONTRACTS**

**PURCHASING DEPARTMENT
CITY OF LINCOLN/LANCASTER COUNTY, NEBRASKA**

1. ESTIMATED QUANTITIES

- 1.1 The quantities set forth in the line items and specification document are approximate and represent the estimated requirements for the contract period.
- 1.2 Items listed may or may not be an inclusive requirements for this category.
- 1.3 Category items not listed, but distributed by bidder are to be referred to as kindred items. Kindred items shall receive the same percentage of discount or pricing structure as items listed in the specification document.
- 1.4 The unit prices and the extended total prices shall be used as a basis for the evaluation of bids. The actual quantity of materials necessary may be more or less than the estimates listed in the specification document, but the City/County shall be neither obligated nor limited to any specified amount. If possible, the Owners will restrict increases/decreases to 20% of the estimated quantities listed in the specification document.

2. CONTRACT PERIOD

- 2.1 The material shall be delivered as ordered during the contract period, beginning from the date of contract execution and ending as indicated in the specifications or in the Attribute Section of the bid.
- 2.2 Bidder must indicate in the Bid, if extension renewals are an option.
- 2.3 By mutual consent of both parties it is understood and agreed that the contract may be renewed at the same prices and/or under the same conditions governing the original contract.

3. BID PRICES

- 3.1 Bidders must state in the Attribute Section if the bid prices will remain firm for the full contract period; or if the bid prices will be subject to escalation/de-escalation.
- 3.2 Escalation/De-escalation Clause: In the event that prevailing market conditions warrant an adjustment in bid prices contained in the contract, the following escalation/de-escalation clause shall be the only clause applicable or acceptable:
 1. Contractor shall give written notice to the Purchasing Agent of any proposed changes from contract prices not less than thirty (30) calendar days prior to the effective date of said price changes.
 2. Such notice must be accompanied by a certified copy of the supplier's advisory or notification to the contractor of price changes.
 3. No price escalation will be authorized in excess of the amount of the increase referred to on the supplier's notice.
 4. Purchasing shall issue a contract Addendum with revised pricing upon receipt and approval. The Addendum will be executed by both parties for the remaining term of the contract.
 5. The approved price change shall be honored for all orders received by the contractor after the effective date of such price change.
 6. Approved price changes are not applicable to orders already issued and in process at time of price change.

7. Purchasing reserves the right to audit and/or examine any pertinent books, documents, papers, records or invoices relating directly to the contract transaction in question after reasonable notice and during normal business hours.
8. The Purchasing Agent retains the right to determine whether or not such proposed price changes are in the best interests of the City/County.
9. If in the opinion of the Purchasing Agent any proposed increase is found unacceptable, the Purchasing Agent reserves the right to cancel the contract upon thirty (30) calendar days written notice.
10. Contractors must tie any price change clause to an industry-wide or otherwise nationally recognized index, or some other form of verifiable document. Contractor will put the Purchasing Agent on the mailing lists for such publication so that the Purchasing Agent can monitor said changes. Such membership will be no cost to the Owners.

4. CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION

- 4.1 The Purchasing Division will issue a Contract to all successful bidders. Such contract will incorporate the specifications and all other forms used during the bid process.
- 4.2 Orders for materials will be made as needed by the various Agencies following execution by all parties.
- 4.3 Contractor may be asked to assist the Purchasing Agent with the development of a list of repetitively purchased commodities, to periodically update such list, and to assist in the development of a list of suitable substitutions.
- 4.4 Contractor shall provide technical advice upon request, and assist in the evaluation of new products.
- 4.5 Contractor shall monitor orders to ensure the highest possible fill rate and minimize back-orders.

5. QUARTERLY REPORT

- 5.1 Upon request, the contractor shall provide to the Purchasing Agent a quarterly report, showing all purchases made under the terms and conditions of the contract.
- 5.2 Such quarterly report shall itemize the following information:
 1. Each ordering department.
 2. Items and quantities purchased by department.
 3. Total dollar amount of purchases by department.
