

Improved “Articulating” Rescue Device



Both of these are already UL Certified to the new 2007 Edition and all the materials used in their construction FAR exceed all minimums. You can see the newer improved articulating version (center & right) has distinct advantages: Under the arms and in all other abrasion areas the smooth Kevlar rope is going to create very little abrasion of the outer shell or moisture barrier unlike the 1.75” wide Kevlar webbing used in older designs. It is so small it can’t be felt when worn. It also adjusts to evenly distribute weight to each armpit while dragging, even if you have to flip the down firefighter from one side to their other side to work around corners.
