

**Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department
2014 Summer Food Service Program
October 14, 2014**

- Thirty-fourth year
- 37 feeding sites in highest need locations
- 88,725 meals served to eligible children; 31,632 breakfasts and 57,093 lunches
- Average of 1,706 meals per day over the 52 days
- Approximately 2,850 children receiving meals
- 42% of the meals to non-white children in Lincoln
- The Food Bank of Lincoln and Lancaster County and Anderson Ford each donated a truck for transportation
- One City of Lincoln vehicle was leased for transportation
- Temporary staff to deliver meals included three full-time drivers and five riders.
- Contract with LPS to prepare meals
- Department of Education administers the USDA school nutrition funds that include the Summer Food Service Program

- 97% of direct expenses were covered by reimbursement
- The 3% remaining direct expenses were covered by community cash donations
- The balance from this year will be saved to offset next summer's costs
