

## LINCOLN-LANCASTER COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

- A. In accordance with Article 2, Section 14 of the Lincoln-Lancaster County Air Pollution Control Program Regulations and Standards (LLCAPPRS), notice is given for the following proposed actions:
1. The preliminary determination by the LLCHD to approve the issuance of a Class II minor source operating permit to ADM Milling Company.
- B. Issuance of the proposed general operating permit allows for continued operation of the subject emission sources with existing Federal, State, and Local requirements. Provided below are the name, address, and the North America Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes describing the nature of business at the subject emission source:
1. Source Name: ADM Milling Company
  2. Address: 540 South Street, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska 68502
  3. NAICS Codes: 311211 Flour Milling and 424510 Grain and Field Bean Merchant Wholesalers
- C. Potential emissions are greater than Class II thresholds but less than the Class I permit thresholds set forth under Article 2, Sections 2 and 5 of the LLCAPPRS. As such, the source is a 'minor' source of emissions, and the issuance of a Class II operating permit is appropriate for this source.
- D. The proposed operating permit will allow for emissions of the following regulated air pollutants in the associated quantities. All quantities are in units of tons per year, or tpy.

- E. The proposed operating permit includes specific conditions based on the Lincoln-Lancaster County Air Pollution Control Program Regulations and Standards, which require the following:
1. Compliance with all self-imposed limits and requirements elected in the source's permit renewal application;
  2. Requires proper operation and maintenance of control devices (if elected);
  3. Prohibits emissions of visible off-site dust emissions;
  4. Requires the source to keep records;
  5. Requires annual reporting of actual throughputs;
  6. Requires the source to pay annual emission fees based on actual emissions.
- F. The proposed operating permit is available for inspection during business hours at the office of the LLCHD at 3140 N Street, Lincoln, NE 68510. - G. The 30-day public comment period commences July 28, 2016 and ends on August 27, 2016. Within the 30-day public comment period, any interested person, agency, or group may request or petition the Director of the LLCHD for a public hearing. All requests for public hearing must be made in writing, and must state the nature of the issues to be raised and all arguments and factual grounds supporting their position. If a public hearing is granted by the Director, the hearing will be advertised by public notice at least 30 days prior to its occurrence. Comments on the proposed permits should be mailed to:
