

PUBLIC NOTICE

LINCOLN-LANCASTER COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

- A. In accordance with Article 2, Section 14 of the Lincoln-Lancaster County Air Pollution Control Program Regulations and Standards (LLCAPCPRS), notice is given for the following proposed actions:
1. The preliminary determination by the LLCHD to approve the issuance of a Construction Permit for Pavers LLC to install and operate a non-metallic mineral crushing plant.
 2. The preliminary determination by the LLCHD to approve the issuance of a Construction Permit for Pavers LLC to install and operate a replacement hot mix asphaltic concrete counter-flow dryer/mixer drum.
- B. Issuance of the proposed permit allows for construction and operation of the subject emission source within Federal, State and Local requirements. Provided below are the name, address, and the North America Industry Classification System (NAICS) code describing the nature of business at the subject emission source:
1. Source Name: Pavers LLC
 2. Source Address: 12303 Highway 6, Waverly, NE 68462
 3. NAICS Code(s): 324121 (Asphalt Paving Mixture and Block Manufacturing); 238910 (Site Preparation Contractors)
- C. Potential emissions exceed the Class I operating permit thresholds and 'Prevention of Significant Deterioration of Air Quality' (PSD) significance set forth under Article 2, Sections 5, 17, and 19 of the LLCAPCPRS, but the owner/operator has agreed to limit throughputs to such quantities that actual emissions will remain below Class I operating permit and PSD significance thresholds. As such, the source will remain a 'synthetic minor' source of emissions. Issuance of the two proposed construction permits is appropriate for this facility. This facility will not be required to obtain a Class I operating permit or PSD construction permit.
- D. The proposed construction permit for the non-metallic mineral crushing plant will allow for emissions of the following regulated air pollutants in the associated quantities. All quantities are in units of tons per year (tpy).

- G. The 30-day public comment period commences July 28, 2016 and ends on August 27, 2016. Within the 30-day public comment period, any interested person, agency, or group may submit comments on the proposed permits, or request or petition the Director of the LLCHD for a public hearing. All requests for public hearing must be made in writing, and must state the nature of the issues to be raised and all arguments and factual grounds supporting their position. If a public hearing is granted by the Director, the hearing will be advertised by public notice at least 30 days prior to its occurrence. Comments on the proposed permits should be mailed to:
