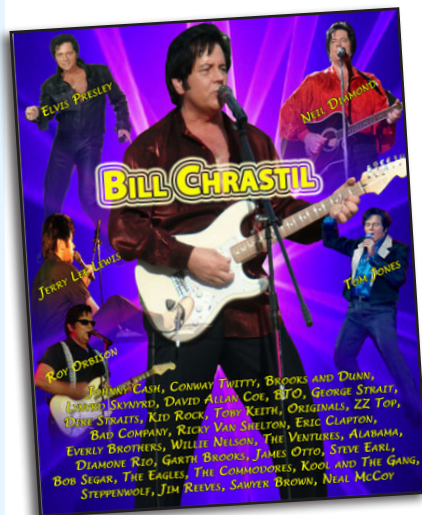
Bill Chrastil: A Salute to the Greats!
