Dr. Krejci has worked at the Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department as the Community Health/Diversity Educator in the Healthy Homes Program since 1993. She serves as a consultant on numerous community boards, committees and groups. She has a Bachelor's degree in Education, Master's degree of Arts in Anthropology and a Masters of Science degree in Counseling. She has a doctorate in Adult Education with research and dissertation in Medical Anthropology.

In addition to teaching junior and senior high and college, she has been involved for over forty years in work and research in cultural diversity. She is fluent in Spanish, and has worked six years in education and community organization in Bogotá and Cáli, Colombia, South America. Dr. Krejci has conducted over 1,400 workshops or sessions with over 20,000 participants from every walk of life in Lincoln, across Nebraska, and in Iowa.
