Door-to-door transportation, including medical, within Lincoln city limits. Wheelchair accessible.

- Day rate is \$3.50 each way - Extended Hours rate is \$2 each way. No change given. Must have exact amount of payment.
- Daytime: Monday-Saturday 6 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.
Extended Hours: Monday - Friday 5 - 11 p.m.
Saturday: 8 a.m. - 11 p.m.
Sunday & Holidays: 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.
- Eligibility: Inability to ride a city bus due to disability.
Call 48-hours in advance to (402) 441-7190.

Other Info: Pre-registration required. Call the League of Human Dignity at (402) 441-7871 for an application. This application will require a physician or other professional to verify need.

Low-Income Monthly Bus Passes

- Fare: \$8 bus pass and \$16 Handi-van pass.
- Must show ID.
- Must present previous month's bus pass.
- Only one pass per person per 31 days.
- Passes can be purchased at different sites around Lincoln. Call for more information.

Senior Saver for Less/Go

- Eligibility: Reduced bus fare for older adults and disabled persons with proper identification: Medicare card, State ID, Senior Savor or Go For Less photo ID card.

Door-to-door Public Rural Transportation, serving the entire Lancaster County area plus the communities of Ceresco, Cortland, Eagle and Greenwood. (Wheelchair accessible.)

- Transit Hours: Monday - Thursday, 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.
Morning pick ups, mid-day transfers available, afternoon returns.
- Office Hours: Monday - Friday, 8 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.
Call to schedule trips as least one day in advance. In-Lincoln transfers are available upon request.
- Fare: \$2 per boarding (\$20 - 10 punch rider card available for your convenience.)

Lincoln Senior Transportation Program

Social transportation. Any destination or purpose such as grocery shopping, banking, beauty shop, visiting friends, nursing homes and religious services.

No medical appointments, not wheelchair accessible.

- Fare: Suggested donation of \$12
- Hours: 7-days a week. Rides are based on volunteer driver availability.
- Eligibility: 65 years and older, must be ambulatory.

Madonna Medical Transportation ☺

Door-to-door transportation for medical and hospital trips only. Lincoln residents only. Wheelchair accessible.

- Fare: \$15 one way doctor appointments or hospital admission. \$67 one-way discharge from hospital, \$16 round trip to regularly scheduled appointments such as dialysis, chemotherapy, physical therapy, etc. when scheduled for six weeks or more.
- Hours: Monday - Saturday, 6 a.m. - 10 p.m.
Sunday, 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.
- Eligibility: Medical related appointments only.

Road to Recovery Transportation

Transportation to and from medical appointments related to cancer treatment. Sponsored by the American Cancer Society. Not wheelchair accessible.

- Fare: No charge.
- Hours: Monday - Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 5 p.m.
- Eligibility: Cancer patients only. Must live in Lincoln. Call 72 hours in advance.
- Must be ambulatory.

Door-to-door transportation including medical. Wheelchair accessible.

- Fare: \$25 one way. Call about other special reduced fares.
- Hours: By reservation only; will travel outside Lincoln city limits for additional cost.
- Eligibility: Disabled, visually impaired or over 60 years old.
