## Direct Service Waiver Request

A public hearing will be conducted by Aging Partners, a community aging services agency sponsored by the City of Lincoln, for the purpose of receiving public comment concerning options in the community for providing delivery of Home Delivered Meals, Congregate Meals, Assisted Transportation, Transportation, Emergency Response System, Durable Medical Equipment, Supportive Services and Volunteer Placement in Lancaster County as well as Chore Service, Nutrition Education, Health Education, Financial Counseling, Health Clinic, Respite-Home, Medication Management, Health Promotion, Disease Prevention, Cash & Counseling, Caregivers Information Services, Caregivers Access Assistance, Caregivers Counseling, Caregivers Respite Care, Caregivers Supplemental Services, and Caregivers Cash & Counseling throughout the eight-county areas of Butler, Fillmore, Lancaster, Polk, Saline, Saunders, Seward and York. Personal Care and Homemaker services are provided in each of the above counties except for Lancaster County.

These comments may include services as are now provided directly by Aging Partners in order to: 1) Assure an adequate supply of services and/or 2) Provide services related to the Area Agency's administrative functions.

The hearing will be held in the lower level conference room of Aging Partners Downtown Senior Center located at 1005 "O" Street on March 22, 2012, 2:00 p.m. at which time all persons interested may be heard.
