


Increase percentage of care management and in-home services clients  
with 3 or more ADLs (Activities of Daily Living in comparison to State average)





with 3 or more ADLs in comparison to State average




Increase the percentage of low-income mothers served by Health Department who obtain 10 or more prenatal visits with the doctor to 95% (Temporary)




Decrease the Lancaster County percentage of live births to teen mothers (under age 20) to less than the Nebraska 2006 average of 8%: Nebraska


