

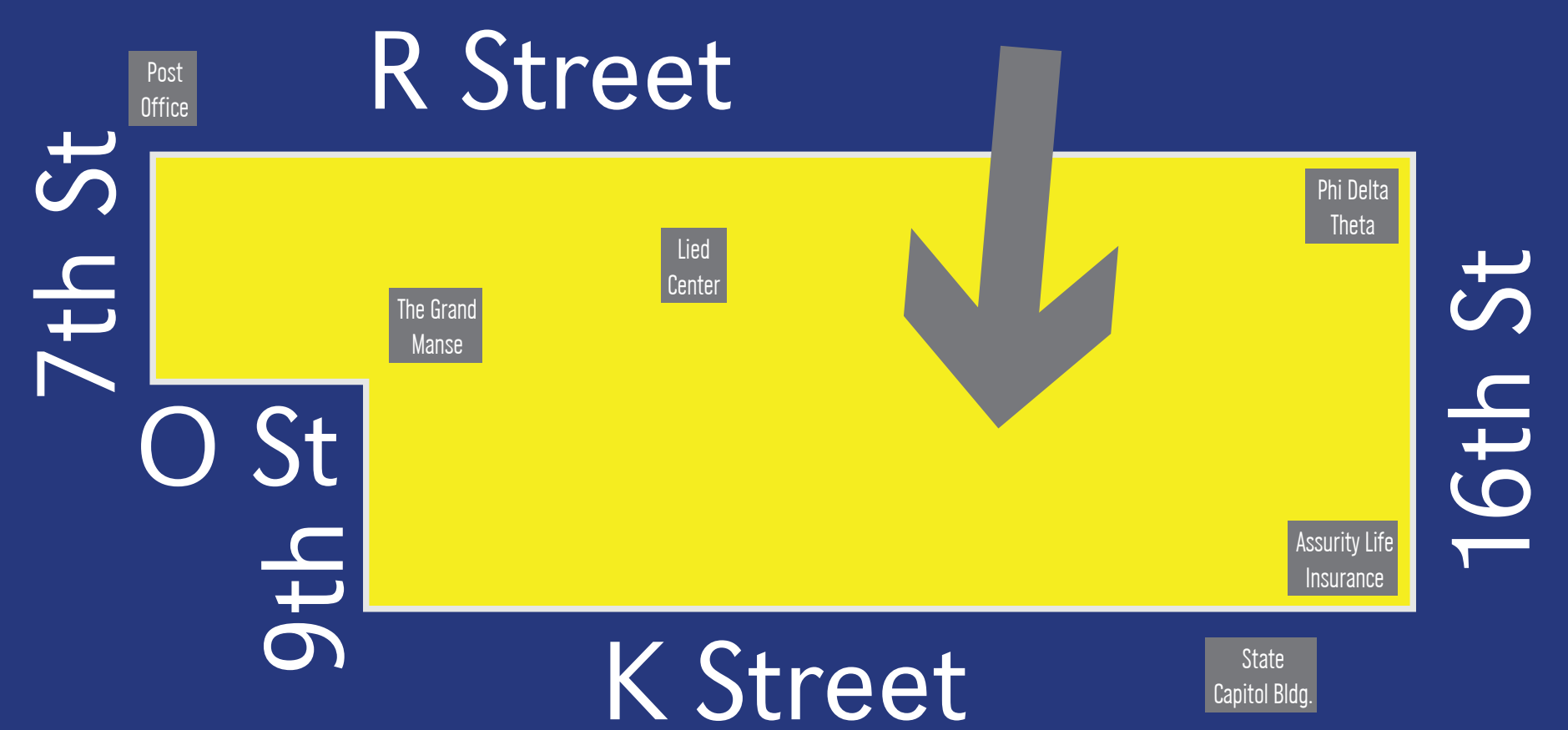
BICYCLING ON UNL CAMPUS

HOW TO CORRECTLY LOCK UP YOUR BIKE

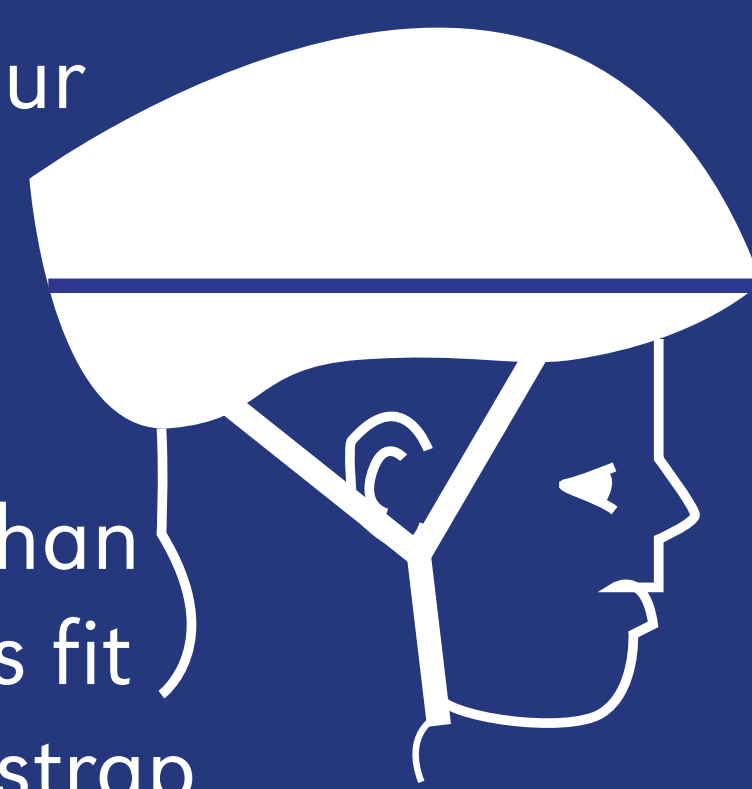


DO NOT RIDE ON SIDEWALKS IN DOWNTOWN AREA



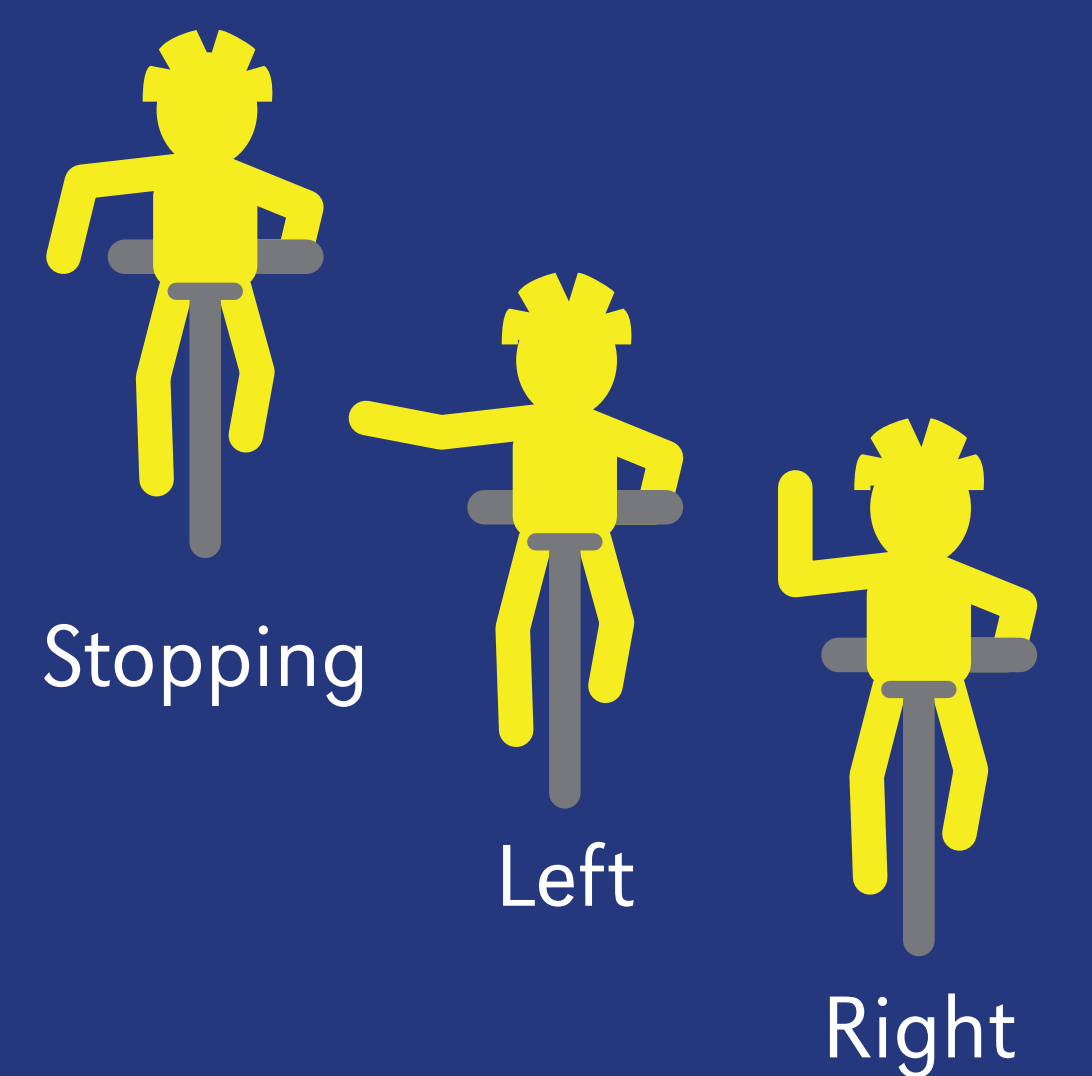
WEAR YOUR HELMET CORRECTLY!

Fits snug and level on your head, and low on forehead. No more than two fingers fit under the strap.



SIGNALING

Always signal when turning or stopping.
(As seen from behind)



REGISTER WITH UNL POLICE!

This will help them locate your bike if it is lost or stolen.

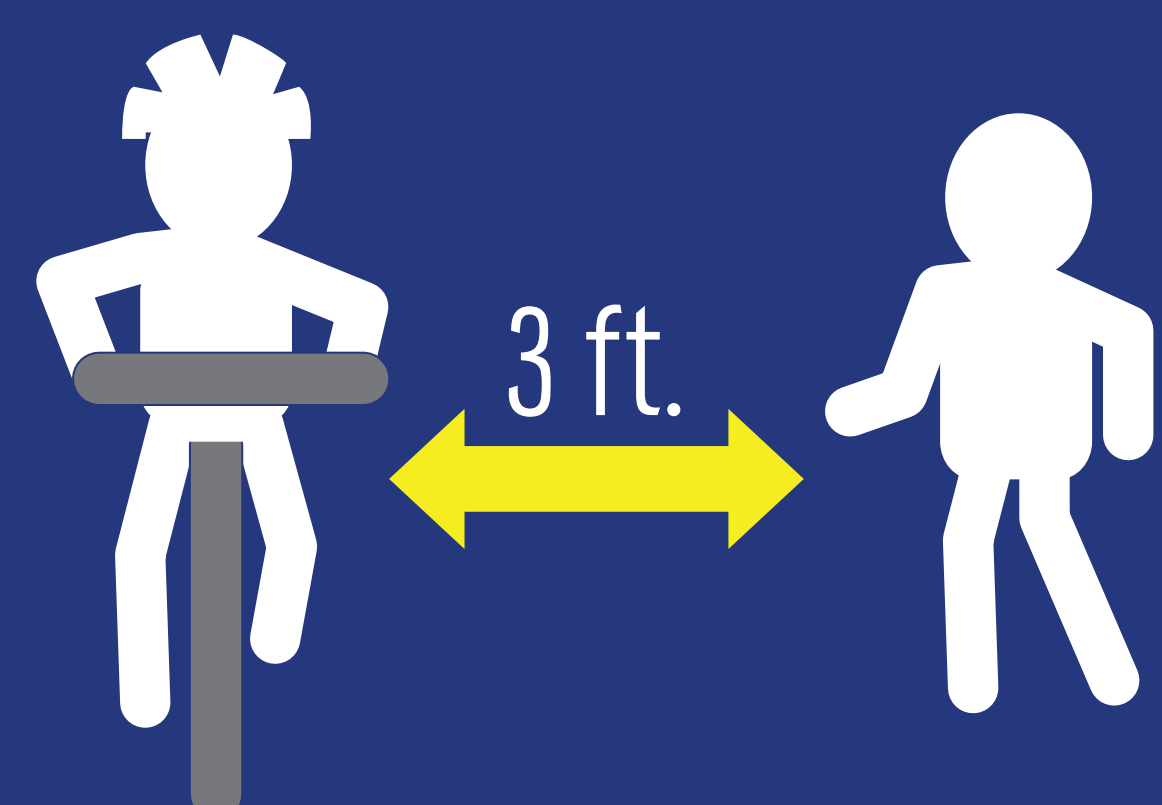
ANNOUNCE YOUR PRESENCE

For example: "On your left!"

UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA-LINCOLN BIKE RIDING POLICY:

- Keep all wheels on the ground while riding.
- "Walk" your bike in heavy pedestrian traffic or if you could disrupt safe pedestrian flow.
- Keep a three foot distance between pedestrians or vehicles when passing.
