Biogas is produced from the anaerobic digestion process at the Theresa Street WWTF and is considered to be an alternative sustainable source for vehicle fuel. Funding is requested in FY 2016-17 and FY 2017-18 for project costs, including land acquisition, environmental study, design and construction. Site selection is in the preliminary phase and is undetermined.
