CONNECTIONS OUTSIDE CITY

17.14.010 Application for Connection.

Any person desiring to connect premises located beyond the corporate limits of the city with a main of the Lincoln Water System shall make application to the Director therefor, setting forth in such application all the information prescribed in Chapter 17.10 of this title, and such other information as the Director may require. The making of all such connections shall be subject to the written approval of the Mayor of the city. (Ord. 13892 §43; July 16, 1984).

17.14.020 Applicant to Execute Agreement.

The applicant for such service to premises located outside of the corporate limits of the city shall enter into a written agreement with the city in such form as the city may prescribe, to be filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Lancaster County, Nebraska, which agreement shall include provisions whereby the applicant agrees to comply with and be subject to the provisions of this title and of Title 24 of the Lincoln Municipal Code. 17.14.030 Location of Meter and Tapping of Main.

If the connection referred to in the preceding section is permitted by the Mayor of the city, the said applicant shall be required to construct and maintain a meter and backflow prevention assembly within a structure or building capable of preventing the meter and/or backflow prevention assembly from freezing at such location, in such manner, and of such materials as may be designated by the Director, provided the structure or building is not considered a confined space by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration. The water main shall be tapped at the place designated by the Director, and shall be done in accordance with the provisions of this title for making connections to water mains.
