Being a leader sometimes includes talking to people about tough or sensitive subjects. Yet many leaders avoid having these kinds of difficult conversations. In November, 2013 Pamela Dingman was appointed the Lancaster County Engineer. Dingman received her Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Nebraska – Lincoln in 1991 and is a Registered Professional Engineer in the states of Nebraska and Iowa.



In 2006, she was named one of the Top Ten Business Women in America by the American Business Women’s Association. Dingman was the first woman to receive the Eastern Nebraska Society of Professional Engineers-Young Engineer of the Year Award and the Nebraska Society of Professional Engineers-Young Engineer of the Year Award in 2000. In 2013, she was the Nebraska American Planning Association Advancing Diversity and Social Change Award
