NATURE OF WORK

This is entry level professional psychiatric work evaluating and diagnosing a variety of diseases and disorders of the mind. This is an unclassified position.

Work involves utilizing a variety of psychotherapeutic methods and medications, and providing patient-oriented consultative services to Mental Health Center staff and other community agencies. Supervision is received from the Clinical Director. This is an unclassified position.

EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED

Provides direct patient care and treatment through evaluation, diagnosis and consultation sessions.

Maintains appropriate patient records of treatment provided and progress achieved.

Performs related work as required by Clinical Director.

DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGES, ABILITIES AND SKILLS

Knowledge of current methods and techniques of treating mental disorders.

Knowledge of the professional principles, practices, and methods involved in providing direct psychiatric treatment to patients.

Ability to coordinate and deliver psychiatric treatment to patients of the Mental Health Center.

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with patients and staff.

DESIRABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

Graduation from an accredited school of medicine with a specialization in psychiatry including completion of an AMA approved residency program.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Graduation from an accredited school of medicine with a specialization in psychiatry including completion of an AMA approved residency program.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENT

Possession of a valid license to practice as a physician in the State of Nebraska.
