7 Amend	56th St from Shadow Pines Dr to Old Cheney Rd Work envisions the completion of the design engineering, right-of-way acquisition, construction and construction engineering necessary to construct four lanes of pavement along 56th Street between Shadow Pines Drive and Old Cheney. The project will construct a center median as well as left and right turn lanes. While the project will mainly improve safety and capacity it also includes significant contributions to the city's pedestrian/bicycle facilities, drainage needs, and provides information vital to the study of the 56th/Old Cheney/Highway 2 Triangle of intersections (LTRP goals of Intersection Capacity Improvements, ITS, Safety Projects, and Travel Demand Management).
