GRADES

Sections:

14.16.010 Streets, Roadways, and Alleys to Be Graded to Established Grade.

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Whenever the City Council shall deem it necessary to grade or repair any street, roadway, or alley, or any part thereof within the city, otherwise than for the purpose of paving, curbing, or guttering the same, they shall order and cause grading, cutting down, or filling up of any such street, roadway, or alley, or any portion thereof to be done as may be necessary to make the same to correspond to the established grade of the streets of said city, as near as may be, and sufficient to keep the same in good repair for public use, the expense thereof to be paid at public cost or as otherwise provided by the City Council. No street, roadway, or alley in said city shall be permanently graded except as the same be ordered done by the City Council.

The grading and repair of streets, roadways, and alleys contemplated herein shall be done under the supervision of the Department of Public Works and Utilities. (Ord. 16951 §94; March 11, 1996: prior Ord. 13022 §1; November 10, 1980: Ord. 3489 §41-701; July 6, 1936).
