Reason for Legislation

The combined Weed Program interlocal Agreement between the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County requires that the Lancaster County Weed Control Authority prepare an annual work plan for approval by the County Commissioners, City Council and Mayor.

Discussion (Including Relationship to other Council Actions)

The interlocal agreement also provides for 50/50 funding of the Authority by the City and County. A budget of \$236,000 has been submitted for approval. The plan anticipates a workload of 4,600 inspections on 2,300 sites in the City of Lincoln for the 2003 season. 4,200 inspections would be for weed abatement and 1,400 inspections for noxious weeds.
