REASON FOR LEGISLATION: This continues the interlocal agreement between the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County to land apply biosolids from wastewater treatment facilities on agricultural land. The program began in 1992. The County and City were interested in updating the language in the agreement regarding current practices related to insurance and update the hold harmless and non-discrimination language in the agreement. The program is administered by the County Cooperative Extension and utilizes roughly 30,000 tons of biosolids annually on Agricultural cropland.
