Widening Project

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:** Approval

**APPLICANT:** Public Works & Utilities

**REASON FOR LEGISLATION:** To provide authority for the Mayor to execute an Interlocal Agreement which will allow the City to construct roadway improvements and acquire Right of Way outside the City of Lincoln corporate limits.

## DISCUSSION

A new two lane roundabout is being constructed as a part of the 14<sup>th</sup> Street widening project at the intersection of 14<sup>th</sup> and Alvo Road. In order to construct the intersection and tie the proposed work into the existing roadway north of Alvo Road, construction, right-of-way, and easement acquisition must occur outside the City limits. The construction outside the City limits consists of roadway improvements, including a splitter island needed for the roundabout and storm sewer needed to drain the new roadway.
