<p>The Council is currently reviewing an Interlocal Agreement between Lancaster County and City of Lincoln whereby the Emergency Communication Center would fall under the management structure of the Lincoln Police Department.</p> <p>This ordinance would amend Sections 2.02.050, 2.02.120, and 2.02.065 of the Lincoln Municipal Code to transfer the Emergency Communication Center (911) from supervision of the Finance Department to that of the Lincoln Police Department.</p> <p>Additionally, L.M.C. 2.02.065 required the Mayor and City Council to take official action on the position of the Public Safety Director by July 2013, or the position would automatically discontinue. This ordinance amendment would delete the July 2013 deadline and make the position permanent.</p> <p>Reallocate funds from the Finance Department to the Police Department.</p>	Sponsor
