The City of Lincoln and The Schemmer Associates wish to enter into an agreement which establish the responsibilities and fees for preliminary engineering and NEPA Phase services for safety improvements at the intersection of North 14th Street & the Eastbound Off-Ramp to U.S. Highway 6 in the City of Lincoln. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has agreed to provide safety funds to cover 90% of the total project costs with the City of Lincoln and State of Nebraska (District 1) each providing a 5% contribution.
