REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To provide authority for the Mayor to sign the contract for the Superior Street & I-180 East Ramp Safety Project. This resolution states that the City concurs with awarding the contract to the lowest bidder. The agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads (NDOR) allows the use of Federal Transportation Program Funds for construction and construction engineering.

D I S C U S S I O N

The City of Lincoln (City) receives competitive apportionment of Federal Highway Safety Improvement funds (HSIP) administered by the Nebraska Department of Roads. The original programming agreement for this project was executed in February 25, 2008.

Bidding will open on April 18th and the bid information will be shared at the public hearing on April 22nd. The cost split will be 100% federal funds pending approval of the use of 100% HSIP Penalty Funds per Resolution A-87272.
