## D I S C U S S I O N

The City of Lincoln and Alfred Benesch & Company wish to enter into an agreement which establish the responsibilities and fees for preliminary engineering and NEPA Phase services for safety improvements at the intersection of N. 66<sup>th</sup> Street & Fremont Street in the City of Lincoln. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has agreed to provide safety funds to cover 90% of the total project costs with the City of Lincoln contributing the remaining 10%.
