REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To provide authority for the Mayor to execute an agreement between the City of Lincoln and Speece Lewis Engineers to provide preliminary and final design services as well as environmental and geotechnical services for the 10th Street bridge over Salt Creek.

DISCUSSION

The City of Lincoln (City) proposes to either rehabilitate or reconstruct the 10th Street bridge over Salt Creek. A study to determine the best option will occur as part of the design process. The City and Speece Lewis Engineers wish to enter into an agreement which establishes the scope and fee for engineering, environmental, and geotechnical services for this project. The State agrees to use the City's Federal Transportation Funds for up to 80% of the actual cost of federal aid eligible items.
