REASON FOR LEGISLATION

To modify the Noise Control Ordinance section:

- 8.24.150 Variances,

to remove specific fee amounts and to provide the City Council with authority to establish and revise fees the City charges for noise variances through Resolution instead of through Ordinance.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

Currently some health code user fees are adopted by Resolution and other user fees are adopted by Ordinance. This requires two different processes by which fees are reviewed and approved by the City Council, making adoption of fee changes somewhat confusing to the public. This year, as part of the biennial budget process, we propose to modify each Ordinance to authorize the City Council to establish and revise fees by Resolution. This will result in a uniform, consistent process by which fees in health codes are updated by the City Council.
