REASON FOR LEGISLATION

Resolution updating fees associated with the Lincoln-Lancaster County Air Pollution Control Regulations and Standards, Article 1, Section 6.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

Incremental fee increases are proposed to revise fees which the City may charge for area sources of air pollution, asbestos notifications, and emergency electrical generators. This revenue will allow the Department to provide required services, including: reviewing, writing and issuing permits; conducting inspections and investigations; monitoring emissions; providing technical consultation; and enforcing the regulations. This revenue is incorporated in the FY15 and FY16 proposed budgets.

Note: Air pollution emission fees are not being changed at this time. These fees will be reviewed this fall/winter with the Air Pollution Control Advisory Board and, if changes are necessary, will be brought to the City Council for action at a later date.
