REASON FOR LEGISLATION

Resolution amending LMC 28.02 Regulations for Illicit Discharges section 28.02.070 Right of Entry; Inspection and Detection; Inspection Fees.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

Incremental fee increases are proposed for the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) stormwater permit compliance inspections. This revenue will allow the Department to provide required services, including: inspections, education, and investigations; assuring the City of Lincoln maintains compliance with its Federal MS4 Stormwater Permit; providing regulated industries compliance guidance; and protecting our stormwater system, lakes and streams from illicit discharges of pollutants. This revenue will allow the Department to provide required services, including reviews, inspections, education, and investigations to the affected industry, and to protect the public from illness. This revenue is incorporated in the FY15 and FY16 proposed budgets.
