

RESOLUTION NO. A-_____

1 WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln through its Parks and Recreation Department
 2 proposes to apply to the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission for financial
 3 assistance from the Recreational Trails Program grant fund for the purpose of
 4 renovating the Murdock Trail from Touzalin Ave. to 70th Street; and

5 WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be \$529,300.00, of which the
 6 Recreational Trails Program request will be \$473,340.00, and the City of Lincoln's cost
 7 will be \$55,960.00; and

8 WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln wishes to express its support for the project and
 9 its willingness to commit the necessary financial resources to operate and maintain the
 10 completed project in a safe and attractive manner for the public.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
 12 Lincoln, Nebraska:

13 1. The City of Lincoln hereby expresses its support for the application being
 14 made by its Parks and Recreation Department to the Nebraska Game and Parks
 15 Commission for financial assistance from the Recreational Trails Program grant fund for
 16 the purpose of renovating the Murdock Trail from Touzalin Ave. to 70th Street and its
 17 commitment to the on-going maintenance of the trail.

18 2. The Mayor and the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department of
 19 the City of Lincoln, Nebraska is authorized to sign the application for federal assistance,
 20 and any other official project documents that are necessary to obtain such assistance,

1 including any agreements, contracts, or other documents that are required by the State
2 of Nebraska or the Federal Highway Administration.

3 3. The City of Lincoln currently has the written commitment for \$55,960.00
4 for the 20% local matching share for the project elements that are identified on the
5 application form and the supplemental documents and will, as it becomes necessary,
6 allocate the local funds for this project.

7 4. The City of Lincoln will commit the necessary financial resources to
8 operate and maintain the completed project in a safe and attractive manner for public
9 use.

10 5. The City of Lincoln will not discriminate against any person on the basis of
11 race, color, age, religion, handicap, sex, or national origin in the use of the proposed
12 project acquired or developed pursuant to the project proposal, and shall comply with
13 the terms and intent of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and any of the regulations
14 promulgated pursuant to such Act.

15 6. The City of Lincoln will comply with all rules and regulations of the
16 Recreational Trails Program, applicable Executive Orders, and all state laws that govern
17 the grant applicant during the performance of the project.

18 7. The City of Lincoln will comply with the federal disability access and use
19 standards where they can be reasonably applied in accordance with the Americans with
20 Disabilities Act.

21 8. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to
22 the Parks and Recreation Department for transmittal to the Nebraska Game and Parks
23 Commission.
