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REASON FOR LEGISLATION

To provide authority for the Mayor to execute an agreement between the City of Lincoln and Olsson Associates to provide NEPA evaluation and documentation for the S 17th Traffic Signals Project.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

The City of Lincoln (City) proposes to evaluate S. 17th & A, S. 17th & D, and S 17th & Washington to determine the appropriate type of vehicular and pedestrian control at each intersection. This project will consist of reviewing traffic counts, pedestrian activity, and sight distance requirements, identifying the type of control needed, and construction activities. The City and Olsson Associates wish to enter into an agreement which establishes the scope and fee for environmental services for this project. The State agrees to use the City's Federal Transportation Funds up to 80% of the actual cost of federal aid eligible items.
