REASON FOR LEGISLATION

The City has previously entered into a Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with the governing boards of Public Safety Answering Points (PSAPs) located within the counties of Cass, Fillmore, Gage, Jefferson, Johnson, Lancaster, Nemaha, Otoe, Pawnee, Richardson, Saline, Seward, Thayer and York. The Interlocal created a Regional Governing Committee and financed the hiring of a consultant to draft a request for proposal for equipment, hardware, and software necessary to create a Southeast Regional 911 system. An amendment is necessary to allow the Committee to review the RFPs, designate a funding mechansim, and work with the governing bodies to approve a contact.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

At this time, other than staff time, there is no costs to the City in amending the Interlocal. Once costs of a 911 system are identified and divided among the parties, the City will have an opportunity to evaluate these costs and determine if the City will continue to be part of the Southeast Regional 911 system.
