REASON FOR LEGISLATION

To provide authority for the Mayor to sign the contract for the 70th Street, Van Dorn to Eastborough Pavement Repair Project. This resolution states that the City concurs with awarding the contract to the lowest bidder. The agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads (NDOR) allows the use of Federal Transportation Program Funds for construction and construction engineering of 70th Street between Van Dorn Street and Eastborough Lane.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

The City of Lincoln (City) receives an annual apportionment of Federal Surface Transportation funds (STP) administered by the Nebraska Department of Roads. The original programming agreement for this project was executed by the City on June 13, 2013 under Resolution A-87360.

Bids are scheduled to open April 16, 2015 and the bid information will be shared at the public hearing scheduled on April 20, 2015. The cost split will be 80% federal funds and 20% local funds.
