REASON FOR LEGISLATION

The proposed code amendment establishes a definition for "fundraising" and expands the list of parks and recreation facilities where alcoholic beverages may be served during fundraising activities to include the Woods Park Tennis Center.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

The Lincoln Municipal Code prohibits consumption of alcoholic beverages in parks and recreation facilities with a few notable exceptions including golf courses and designated facilities in conjunction with fundraising activities for benefit of the Parks and Recreation Department or other City departments. Facilities must be closed to access by the general public when fundraising events where alcoholic beverages are being served are being conducted. Alcoholic beverages are to be served by a licensed caterer to monitor consumption and an annual report is submitted to the City Council regarding fundraising activities where alcoholic beverages are served.

The Friends of Woods Tennis and the Lincoln Parks Foundation have requested consideration of expanding the list of designated facilities where alcoholic beverages may be served during fundraising activities to include the Woods Park Tennis Center. The tennis center renovation campaign committee would like to have at least one fundraising activity later this year at the tennis center where alcoholic beverages would be available.
