### REASON FOR LEGISLATION

To provide authority for the Mayor to execute a Funding Agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads (NDOR), for the rehabilitation of the L55X bridge over Salt Creek on N. 56<sup>th</sup> Street.

### DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

NDOR intends to rehabilitate the L55X (N 56<sup>th</sup> Street) bridge over Salt Creek. The project will consist of redecking the bridge, replacing the approaches, and removal of the median barrier within the limits of the project. This project is being designed by NDOR and construction will be handled and supervised by NDOR. The bridge is located within the corporate limits of the City of Lincoln and because of this the City is required to pay 20% of the costs for the project for preliminary engineering, construction and construction engineering. The City's estimated cost for this project is estimated to be \$493,728


