REASON FOR LEGISLATION

Approve a resolution for the signing of Supplement #3 to the Preliminary Engineering and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Services Agreement between the City of Lincoln and The Schemmer Associates for this Federal Aid project.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

Due to additional coordination efforts with the Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR) and the University of Nebraska-Lincoln (UNL) the project schedule has extended beyond what was originally anticipated and thus The City of Lincoln and The Schemmer Associates wish to enter into a Supplemental agreement, which will increase the fees, for preliminary engineering and NEPA Phase services for safety improvements at the intersection of N. 14th St. & the Eastbound Off-Ramp to U.S. Highway 6 in the City of Lincoln. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has agreed to provide safety funds to cover 90% of the total project costs with the City of Lincoln and State of Nebraska (District 1) each providing a 5% contribution.


